To launch the competitive entrance examination into year one of the first cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), University of Yaoundé I, and to fix the number of places available for the 2022/2023 academic year.

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination into year one of the first cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (École normale supérieure - ENS), University of Yaoundé I, for the 2022/2023 academic year has been launched in the following series:

Series	Number of places
Computer Sciences	10
Cameroonian Languages and Cultures	10
French Modern Letters	10
Mathematics	10
Total	40

Article 2 :

- (1) The examination shall be organised in one sitting to Cameroonians of both sexes who are holders of "Baccalauréat" or GCE Advanced Level requested in subsequent series.
- (2) The "Cameroonian languages and cultures" series shall be opened to holders of GCE A/L in at least two (2) subjects including "French" and at least four (4) GCE O/L subjects in one sitting excluding 'Religious Knowledge'.
- (3) The table below specifies the series of "Baccalauréat" and the subjects candidates must pass in the GCE Advanced Level, to be qualified to register for the competitive entrance examination in a given series.

Series	Type of « Baccalauréat » or Subject at GCE AL
Computer Sciences	Baccalauréat C, D, E, F or TI
Cameroonian languages and cultures	Baccalauréat A4 (option Allemand ou Espagnol) ABI or A2. French for the GCE AL
French Modern Letters	Baccalauréat A4 (option Allemand ou Espagnol), ABI, A1 or A2
Mathematics	Baccalauréat C, D, E or TI

Article 3:

- (1) Foreign candidates may be allowed to sit for the examination, under the same academic conditions and according to the number of places available, in conformity with the regulations in force.
- (2) Candidates who are not civil servants must not be more than 29 years old as of January 1st 2022. Age waivers will not be granted.

Article 4: The application files shall comprise all the following documents:

- A registration form available at ENS/University of Yaoundé I, at each examination Centre (Regional Centres of MINESEC), on the website of MINESUP- <http://www.minesup.gov.cm>

and on the website of ENS- <http://www.ens.cm>

- A certified photocopy of the birth certificate which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- Photocopies of transcripts of Probatoire or GCE O/L and Baccalauréat or GCE A/L signed or certified by the competent boards as well as results slips;
- A certified true photocopy of Baccalauréat or GCE A/L or equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education, which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue, or a certificate of achievement signed or certified by the competent academic authority.

Candidates preparing for the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L for the 2021/2022 session shall present their diploma in due time. They will be required to present evidence of success, attested by the competent authority and within a specific time limit, if they are successful in the entrance examination.

- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer, from the Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching. It should particularly specify that the candidate does not suffer from serious physiological deficiencies in his/her diction, hearing, sight and mobility;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as registration fees delivered either by Express Union or MTN Mobile Money or by the SGC Bank - account N° 10003-00200-05021127352-53. No other method of payment will be accepted;
- One A4 self-addressed stamped envelope;
- Two passport-size photographs;
- An authorisation to sit for the examination issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of Higher Education, for candidates working in these Ministries.

Article 5 : Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either a true copy of the ministerial order granting equivalence or a receipt showing that they have submitted an application for equivalence in the Ministry of Higher Education. These documents must be issued by the Minister of Higher Education. Such candidates can be finally admitted into ENS only if they are granted equivalence for their foreign diplomas or certificates within the date limit set out by the competent authority.

Article 6 : Money paid as registration fee for the examination stated in Article 4 above will be non-refundable.

Article 7 : Complete application files should be submitted to the Admission Office of ENS latest 21st September 2022 and 16th September 2022 for regional centres.

Article 8 : The selection through a written examination shall comprise the following components:

- a. Academic performance representing 25% of the total assessment;
- b. Two written papers representing 75% of the total assessment.

Article 9: Marks for academic performance shall be distributed on the basis of:

- the candidate's age ;
- the number of years spent in secondary school;
- candidate's marks obtained in Probatoire or GCE O/L and in Baccalaureat or GCE A/L.

Article 10: The written papers will take place on **Saturday, September 24th 2022** in the

following examination centers: **Bafoussam, Douala, Ebolowa and Yaoundé.**

Article 11 : The distribution of papers per series is indicated in the following table:

Séries	Paper one (3h) (coef. 4)	Paper two (3h) (coef. 2)
Computer sciences	Mathematics	Test of logical reasoning
Cameroonian languages and cultures	French or English Language	General knowledge
French Modern Letters	French Language	Dissertation/ Essay
Mathematics	Algebra and Analysis	Geometry

- (1) The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination in each section are the same as in the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L programmes.
- (2) Marks for each paper of the written test range from zero to twenty according to the above-mentioned coefficients. Any candidate who scores less than five on twenty shall be disqualified.
- (3) The jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates following the different series, and in order of merit.
- (4) In no circumstances will there be any report of cases considered successful related to one academic year to another.

Article 12 : The composition of the jury mentioned in the above articles is specified by a particular text from the Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the regulation in force.

Article 13 : Final results shall be published by the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 14 : Fraudulent admission by non-compliance with the condition of diploma, degree, age or seniority exposes the candidate concerned to automatic exclusion at any time and without any form of procedure.

Article 15 : The Rector of the University of Yaoundé I, the Director for the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), each in his/her own sphere, is responsible for the implementation of this order, which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
