To launch the competitive entrance examination into **year one of the second cycle** of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), University of Yaoundé I, and to fix the number of places available for the 2022/2023 academic year.

- Mindful Of Decree N° 2020/231 of 22nd April 2020 to appoint staff members in certain state universities ;
- Mindful of Order N°18220053 /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDAC of 16th march 2022 to organize the calendar for competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and Institutions of Cameroon State Universities for 2022-2023 academic year;
- Mindful of Circular N° 004/CAB/PM of 10th February 2000 concerning the admission into national training institutions and the recruitment into the Public Service;
- Following the proposal of the Rector of the University of Yaounde I ;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination into year one of the 2nd cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (École normale supérieure - ENS), University of Yaoundé I for the 2022/2023 academic year has been launched in the following series:

Article 2:

(1) The examination shall be organised in one sitting for Cameroonians of both sexes following the conditions stipulated below:

- Section of Student Teachers of Secondary General Education except the Computer Sciences series:

- Candidates should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree or "Licence" corresponding to the series opted for or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education.

- Section of Computer Sciences – Information and Communication Technology Option

- Candidates should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree or "Licence" in Arts and Letters, Bachelor's degree or "Licence" in Human sciences (History, Geography, psychology...), Bachelor's degree or "Licence" in Social sciences (Law, Economics, Management...), Bachelor's Degree or "Licence" in experimental sciences (Biology, Geology, Chemistry, Physics), Bachelor's Degree or "Licence" in Mathematics or any equivalent diploma recognized by the Minister of Higher Education.

- Section of Guidance Counselling

- Candidates should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree or "Licence" in Education Sciences, Economics, Social and Human Sciences, Law, Political Science or in Arts, or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education.

(2) Foreign candidates may be authorised to sit for the examination in the same academic conditions and according to the number of places available, in conformity with the regulations in force.

(3) Candidates who are not civil servants must not be older than **32 years on January 1st 2022**. Age waivers will not be granted.

Article 3: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- A registration form available at ENS/University of Yaoundé I, at each examination Centre (Regional Centres of MINESEC), on the website of MINESUP- <http://www.minesup.gov.cm>- and on the website of ENS- <http://www.ens.cm>
- A certified photocopy of birth certificate which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- Photocopies of transcripts of levels I, II, and III of "Licence" or Bachelor's Degree signed or certified by competent academic authorities;
- A certified photocopy of "Licence" or Bachelor's Degree or equivalent diploma which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue, or a certificate of achievement signed or certified by the competent academic authority;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer, from the Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching. It should particularly specify that the candidate does not suffer from serious physiological deficiencies in his diction, hearing, sight, and mobility;

- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as registration fees delivered either by Express Union or MTN Mobile Money or by the SGC Bank - account N° 10003-00200-05021127352-53. No other method of payment will be accepted;
- One A4 self-addressed stamped envelope;
- Two passport-size photographs;
- An authorisation to sit for the examination issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of Higher Education, for civil servants working in these Ministries.

Article 4: Registration fees paid for the competitive examination are non-refundable.

Article 5: Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either a true copy of the ministerial order granting equivalence or a receipt showing that they have submitted an application for equivalence in the Ministry of Higher Education. These documents must be issued by the Minister of Higher Education. Such candidates can be finally admitted into ENS only if they are granted equivalence for their foreign diplomas or certificates within the date limit set out by the competent authority.

Article 6: Complete application files should be submitted to the Admission Office of ENS latest **21st September 2022** and **16th September 2022** for regional centres.

Article 7: The selection through a written examination shall comprise the following components:

- Academic performance representing 25% of the total assessment;
- Two written papers representing 75% of the total assessment.

Article 8: The academic performance will mostly be based on:

- the candidate's age;
- the number of years spent in the University for the Bachelor's Degree or "Licence";
- transcripts of levels I, II, and III of Licence or Bachelor's Degree in the area of specialization and grades.

Article 9: (1) The written part of the examination will take place on **Sunday, September 25th 2022** in **Bafoussam, Douala and Yaoundé**. The distribution of papers per series is indicated in the table below:

- (2) The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination are the same as those of the Bachelor's Degree or "Licence".
- (3) The grading of each written paper ranges from zero to twenty according to the above-mentioned coefficients. Any score below five on twenty is eliminatory.
- (4) The Jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates following the respective series and in order of merit.
- (5) Final results shall be published by the Minister of Higher Education.
- (6) In no circumstances will there be any report of cases considered successful related to one academic year to another.



Article 10: The composition of the jury shall be specified by the Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the rules and regulations in force.

Article 11: Fraudulent admission by non-compliance with the condition of diploma, degree, age or seniority exposes the candidate concerned to automatic exclusion at any time and without any form of procedure.

Article 12: The Rector of the University of Yaoundé I, the Director for the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) are responsible, each in his/her own domain, for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need be.
